ORDINANCE NO. B-5-95-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE B-2-70 TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON MAIN STREET FROM FRIENDSHIP DRIVE TO LIBERTY STREET EVERY FRIDAY BETWEEN 5 A.M. AND 7 A.M..

WHEREAS, it is necessary to properly remove snow and debris from Main Street in order to preserve the street surface, provide open parking and keep Main Street attractive, and


WHEREAS, it is necessary to prohibit parking for a short period in order to properly maintain the street.

NOW, THEREFORE be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. No person who is an owner, agent, operator or other person in charge of a vehicle shall permit any vehicle to be parked on Main Street from Friendship Drive to Liberty Street between the hours of 5 a.m. and 7 a.m. on Fridays.

SECTION 2. Whoever violates any part of this ordinance shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than \$10.00.


