ORDINANCE NO. D-10-86-2

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. D-7-75-1 RELATIVE TO THE TAPPING CHARGES FOR WATER TAPS AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, It is in the best interest and for the immediate preservation of the safety and welfare of the Village of New Concord, that the rates for tapping charges set in 1975 be increased to cover costs of inflation and other factros.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. D-7-75-1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Tapping Charges. That the following charges shall be made for connection to the Village wager supply system:

3/4 inch	350.00 plus cost of meter
1 inch	375.00 plus cost of meter
2 inch	450.00 plus cost of meter

For all taps outside the corporation there shall be an additional charge of 35% of the base tapping charge plus cost of meter.

Section 2. That for the reasons stated in the preamble which is hereby made a part hereof, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
