ORDINANCE NO. D-11-95-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. D-12-82-1 PERMITTING AND CONTROLLING THE USE OF DISH TYPE SATELLITE RECEIVING STATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has become aware of changes in technology in the area of dish type satellite receiving stations; and

WHEREAS, modern satellite receiving stations may be acceptable where not permitted by Ordinance No. D-12-82-1; and


NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The use of dish type satellite receiving stations regulated by Ordinance No. D-12-82-1 shall remain in effect, however variances to the requirements in Sections 1-6 may be granted by the Board of Zoning Appeals as governed and regulated by Ordinance No. K-5-94-1.

SECTION 2. Permits for satellite dish antennas complying with the provisions of Ordinance No. D-12-82-1 shall be issued by the Zoning Inspector.


SECTION 3. For the reasons stated in the preamble, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period permitted by law.




