Ordinance No. D-3-90-1

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER TAPS TO PROPERTIES LOCATED OUTSIDE THE VILLAGE LIMITS WHEN COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER BILLS ARE DELINQUENT FOR MORE THAN NINETY (90) DAYS.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord operates a Village water system; and

WHEREAS, it is impractical and uneconomical for the Village to permit the use of commercial water taps to the area outside of the Village corporation limits; and

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord currently has in effect Ordinance No. D-7-86-2 which prohibits additional water taps to properties located outside Village limits; and

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord has an obligation to provide water and sewer service to its residential users, and on occasion has contracted with individuals outside the Village limits to supply them with water and sewer services; and

WHEREAS, the present volume and use of water services and water system leakage has created a strain on the system which at times causes a reduction in water pressure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord has, during particularly dry summers, had severely diminished water supplies and has declared a water emergency; and

WHEREAS, the volume and use of water and sewer services of commercial users located outside the Village limits has created additional strain upon the water supply system of the Village of New Concord; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare to remove all commercial water taps which are located outside the city limits and are delinquent in the payment of their water and sewer bills for more than ninety (90) days.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Village of New Concord shall remove all commercial water taps for properties located outside the Village corporate limits which are more than ninety (90) days delinquent in the payment of their water and sewer bills.

Section 2. The Village of New Concord shall not permit the issuance or reissuance of water taps for commercial property located outside the Village corporate limits. This section shall prohibit the reissuance of water taps to commercial properties which were formerly issued water taps which were removed under the authority of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
