

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. D-3-91-1

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ADDITIONAL WATER AND SEWER TAPS TO PROPERTY LOCATED OUTSIDE THE VILLAGE LIMITS WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. D-7-86-2.

WHEREAS, in 1986 by Ordinance No. D-7-86-2, the Council of the Village of New Concord passed an ordinance to prohibit additional water taps to property located outside the Village limits without permission of Village Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Concord desires to also prohibit additional sewer taps to properties located outside the Village limits without permission of Village Council; and

WHEREAS, it is advisable to consolidate the provisions of Ordinance No. D-7-86-2 with the provisions contained in this ordinance, and then repeal all previous ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord owns and provides for the operation of the Village water system and the Village sewer system; and

WHEREAS, it is impractical and uneconomical for the Village to permit additional water taps and sewer taps to areas outside the Village corporation limits; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the Village to immediately stop further water taps and sewer taps outside the Village corporation limits without permission of the Village council.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. D-7-86-2 be and hereby is repealed.

SECTION 2. The Village of New Concord shall not permit additional water taps or sewer taps for properties located outside the Village corporation limits without permission of the Village Council.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
