

ORDINANCE NO. D-4-91-1

An Ordinance canceling the existing street lighting agreement and authorizing the Mayor to enter into a new agreement for street lighting in the Village of New Concord, Ohio.

WHEREAS, Ohio Power Company has indicated that it believes it is in the best interest for the Village of New Concord to terminate the Street Lighting Agreement which was enacted September 8, 1986, by virtue of the authority of Ordinance No. D-7-86-1, and

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord agrees that Ohio Power Company's street lighting tariff, Tariff S.L., is a more economic basis for the lighting of the Village streets.

NOW, therefore,

1. The Village of New concord agrees to the cancellation of Ordinance No. D-7-86-1.
2. The Village of New Concord agrees to accept Tariff S.L.
3. The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement for street lighting service.
