

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. D-5-93-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE D-3-91-1 AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord prohibits the creation of water and sewer taps outside the Village limits; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to allow the creation of temporary taps for property owners that have petitioned the Muskingum County Commissioners for annexation into the Village; and

WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this ordinance is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Village Administrator may issue temporary water and sewer taps to property owners who have petitioned for annexation.

Section 2. Temporary water and sewer taps shall be effective for a period of time, not to exceed one year.

Section 3. The Village may require property owners to enter into an agreement with the Village regarding annexation, removal or installation of taps, zoning or other conditions.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
