

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. B-10-96-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. B-2-68 AND TO ESTABLISH SECTION 351.13 OF THE TRAFFIC CODE TO PROHIBIT PARKING FOR COMMERCIAL VEHICLES ON CERTAIN VILLAGE STREETS.

WHEREAS, existing ordinances prohibit commercial traffic on certain streets, and

WHEREAS, certain vehicles are currently prohibited from parking on Main Street, and

WHEREAS, commercial vehicles parking on Village streets may be unsafe for vehicular and pedestrian traffic and may be objectionable to residents, and


NOW, therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord:

Section 1: No person shall park a truck, bus, tractor, commercial and/or heavy vehicle on any street or highway under local jurisdiction, for any purpose other than loading or unloading except that such vehicles may also park on Main Street for a period not to exceed two hours and provided however, that trucks of one ton capacity or less and vehicles operated by or under contract with a public utility are exempt from the provisions of this section.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect beginning on May 1, 1997.


Section 3: Any person that violates this section shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor punishable as required by law.


