

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. B-7-14-2

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHED TO LIMIT PARKING ON MAIN STREET FROM STATE ROUTE NO. 83 TO LIBERTY STREET TO A PERIOD OF TWO CONTINUOUS HOURS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there are certain areas of the Village it is in the public interest to prevent long-time parking; and

WHEREAS, this situation now exists and it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety to place limitations on parking within the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. That no person who is the owner, agent, operator or other person in charge of any vehicle shall permit said vehicle to remain parked, standing or abandoned upon Main Street in the Village from State Route No. 83 to Liberty Street for a continuous period longer than two hours, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday thru Saturday.


Section 2. Whoever violates any part of this ordinance shall be considered to have committed a misdemeanor and be fined not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00).

Section 3. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
