

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. B-9-00-1

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PORTIONS OF STORMONT STREET AND WEST HIGH STREET TO BE ONE WAY STREETS.

WHEREAS, Village Council has authorized improvements to W. High Street and Stormont Street in order to improve drainage and create needed parking; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to regulate traffic over Stormont Street and W. High Street to provide for the uninterrupted flow of traffic over said streets for the preservation of public property, safety and general welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to operate any vehicle on the following designated streets in any direction other than that indicated.

- A. Stormont Street traffic shall be one-way south bound only at all times from West High Street to Main Street.
- B. West High Street shall be one-way west bound only at all times from the west property line of 66 West High Street to Stormont Street.


Section 2. A. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle for any purpose in a direction other than with the designated direction for the flow of traffic as provided for in Section 1. It shall be unlawful to park in any area on the north side of West High Street from College Drive to Stormont Street. It shall be unlawful to park on West High Street from the west property line of 66 W. High Street to Stormont Street except that vehicles may park in the designated angle parking spaces when said vehicles is of sufficient size to park so as to be fully contained within one designated space. Parking in said area for a period in excess of 10 hours shall be unlawful.

B. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle except for school buses on the west side of Stormont St. from High Street to Main Street between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. It shall be unlawful to park on the east side of Stormont Street from High St. to Main Street except that vehicles may park in the designated parking spaces when said vehicles is of sufficient size to park so as to be fully contained within one designated space. Parking in said area for a period in excess of 10 hours shall be unlawful.

Section 3. The term "vehicles" as used in this ordinance means everything on wheels or runners, except vehicles belonging to any police department, municipal fire department or volunteer fire department organized under the laws of this State when said vehicles are being used by such departments in the discharge of their duties.


Section 4. Whoever violates this ordinance shall be subject to all penalties as provided for in General Offences and Traffic Code of the Village of New Concord and the Ohio Revised Code.


