

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. C-9-03-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE C-1-96-1 ESTABLISHING SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL REGULATIONS FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, regulations establishing permits for garbage and refuse collection and disposal were adopted by Ordinance No. C-2-93-1; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend said regulations to preserve street surfaces and provide convenience to Village residents.

NOW, THEREFORE be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that:

Section 2.02 of Ordinance No. C-1-96-1 shall be abolished and shall be replaced as follows:

Section 2.02 Routes and Schedules for Collection.

Residential refuse shall be collected regularly in the Village on Wednesday only, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except when a legal holiday occurs or weather problems occur on the collection day, may be changed for that week only.

Commercial refuse and special residential pick-ups may be collected Monday through Saturday between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

No refuse collection vehicle exceeding one rear axle shall use or be permitted to use or travel on the following residential streets except with special written permission from the Chief of Police:

Any alley that is not a necessary route for commercial refuse collection: Fairview Drive, Barrington Ridge, Garfield Avenue, Harper Street, Maple Avenue (between Layton and Franklin), Cherry Lane, Franklin Avenue, W. High Street, Highland Avenue, Westview Drive, Longview Lane, McCall's Lane, Hillcrest Drive, Lincoln Lane, Snoots Lane, Lowery Lane, Montgomery Blvd., Paden Drive, Eastview Drive, Mulberry Lane, Hawthorn Lane, Buckeye Drive, Chestnut Alley and Fern Ridge Circle.

Section 12.00 and 13.00 shall be added as follows:

12.00 Revocation of Permit


The Village Administrator may revoke any refuse haulers license or permit for any person, firm or corporation found to be in violation with, or not in full compliance with the terms and conditions of this ordinance. License fees shall not be refunded.

13.0 Penalty

Any person, firm or corporation performing solid waste collection or disposal within the Village of New Concord without a proper permit as described in Section 6.00 of this ordinance shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor and may be punished as permitted by the Ohio Revised Code.






