

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

**ORDINANCE NO. C-9-03-2**

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTING OR PLACING UTILITIES, FACILITIES OR OBSTRUCTIONS WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAYS.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord has previously established certain rules and regulations regarding improvements to be made within the Village limits; and

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord desires to protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens along with preserving the natural beauty of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has previously established certain rules and committees to help protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1. For all utilities which will be placed on public right-of-ways, the entity seeking to establish or construct utilities on those right-of-ways shall first obtain permission from the appropriate officer of the Village of New Concord.

Section 2. The Village of New Concord shall have the authority to require that the utilities or obstructions to be buried, moved or require other restrictions which would work to satisfy Village Council's concerns for the health, safety and welfare of their citizens along with improve and protect the beauty of the Village.

Section 3. No utilities, facilities or obstructions shall be placed anywhere in the Village of New Concord without first obtaining a permit from the appropriate Village authority.


Section 4. Any person, firm, or corporation guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a 4<sup>th</sup> degree misdemeanor punishable as permitted by the Ohio Revised Code.


