**ORDINANCE NO. D-1-03-1**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. D-9-99-1 AND D-2-91-2 ESTABLISHING CHARGES AND RATES FOR USE OF THE VILLAGE SEWER SYSTEM AND FOR TAPS TO THE VILLAGE SEWER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Concord must establish sewer rates in order to operate the sewer system; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that revised rates for sewer use be established, such rates to become effective beginning the March 1, 2003 billing period. These revised charges are necessary for the cost and expense of operating the sewer system for the Village of New Concord; and

WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this ordinance is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, as follows:

Section 1. For the use and the service rendered by said sewage works, rates and charges shall be collected from the owners of each and every lot, parcel of real estate or building that is connected with the Village sanitary system or otherwise discharges sanitary sewage, industrial wastes, water or other liquids, either directly or indirectly, into the sanitary sewerage system of the Village of New Concord.

- a. The sewage rates and charges shall be based on the quantity of water used (based on water meter readings) on or in the property or premises subject to such rates. Sewage service bills shall be rendered once every two (2) months (or period equaling two (2) months). The schedule on which said rates and charges shall be determined as follows:

Users within the Village of New Concord Corporation limits:

\$4.50 per 1,000 gallons  
Minimum bi-monthly charge = \$18.00

Users outside the Village of New Concord Corporation limits:

\$9.00 per 1,000 gallons  
Minimum bi-monthly charge = \$36.00

Users outside the Village of New Concord Corporation limits that are a bonifide public sewer district with a master meter:

\$7.87 per 1,000 gallons

- b. User whose water flow is not metered and or users without an approved water meter shall be required to purchase and install a meter approved for sanitary sewer flow.

Section 2. Tapping Charges. The following charges shall be made for connection to the Village sewer system based on the size of water tap.

¾ inch - \$750

1 inch - \$800

2 inch - \$2,800

4 inch - \$4,500


6 inch - \$6,000

Section 3. Property owners shall be responsible for meter and all labor, equipment, materials, and permits to install the tap. Sewer taps shall be installed using methods and materials approved by the Village and County Health Department. All sewer taps shall be inspected and tested as required by the Village prior to use.

Section 4. The property owner shall be responsible for proper maintenance and repair of all sewer lines and appurtenances including the tap and any subsequent damage to a sewer main caused by tapping the sewer main.


Section 5. That the rates and charges set forth herein shall be in full force on the effective dates listed above.
