**ORDINANCE NO. D-4-04-1**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. D-1-03-2 ESTABLISHING CHARGES AND RATES FOR WATER SERVICE AND FOR WATER USE TO THE VILLAGE WATER SYSTEM AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Concord must establish water service rates in order to operate the water system; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that revised rates for water service be established; such rates to become effective beginning the July 1, 2004 billing period. These revised charges are necessary for the cost and expense of operating the water system for the Village of New Concord in compliance with rules and regulations of the Environmental Protection Agency.

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is necessary to the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord as follows:

Section 1. That all properties within the Village Corporation limits to which a connection is made to the Village Water System shall be charged for water based on water consumption per bi-monthly period, which shall be computed as follows:

First 4,000 gallons	\$6.25 per 1,000 gallons
Next 8,000 gallons	\$5.75 per 1,000 gallons
Over 12,000 gallons	\$5.00 per 1,000 gallons

The minimum water charge per bi-monthly period is \$25.00.

Section 2. That all properties outside the Village Corporation limits to which a connection is made to the Village Water System shall be charged for water based on water consumption per bi-monthly period, which charges shall be computed as follows:

First 4,000 gallons	\$12.50 per 1,000 gallons
Next 8,000 gallons	\$11.50 per 1,000 gallons
Over 12,000 gallons	\$10.00 per 1,000 gallons

The minimum water charge per bi-monthly period is \$50.00.

Section 3. Tapping Charges established by Ordinance No. D-1-03-2 shall remain in effect.

Section 4. Rules and policies established by Village Council or the Village Administrator in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code shall govern customers use, billing, shut offs and other actions necessary for the property operation of the water system.

Section 5. Restrictions and fees for taps outside the corporation limit established by Ordinance No. D-1-03-2 shall remain in effect.

Section 6. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
