

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. E-11-96-2

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. E-12-95-1, TO GRANT AN INCREASE IN SALARY IN RECOGNITION OF INITIATIVE AND SERVICE TO THE VILLAGE AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. E-12-95-1 established salaries and wages for 1996, including Edward Stewart, and;

WHEREAS, Mr. Stewart has been evaluated upon the anniversary date of hire as set forth in Village policy, and;

WHEREAS, Edward Stewart has performed his duties in an exemplary manner, showing initiative and service over and above that required by his job description, and;


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest and for the immediate preservation of the safety and welfare of the Village that an hourly increase of 2.3% be granted Mr. Stewart.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. The annual salary for Edward Stewart be \$24,554 retroactive to September 23, 1996.


