

ORDINANCE NO. E-11-97-4

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. E-2-96-1 TO EMPLOY A REPLACEMENT POLICE OFFICER, TO ESTABLISH A SALARY AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest and for the immediate preservation of the safety and welfare of the Village that police officer be hired; and


WHEREAS, several candidates have been interviewed and Michael LeMar was selected as the best candidate for the job.

NOW, THEREFORE be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. Michael LeMar shall be employed as a police officer for the Village of New Concord effective November 24, 1997 at an annual salary of \$16,900, with a six month probationary period.




