ORDINANCE NO. E-4-02-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. E-6-01-1 TO EMPLOY AN ADDITIONAL POLICE OFFICER, TO ESTABLISH A SALARY AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest and for the immediate preservation of the safety and welfare of the Village that a police officer be hired; and


WHEREAS, several candidates have been interviewed and Trevor Fusner was selected as the best candidate for the job.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. Trevor Fusner shall be employed as a police officer for the Village of New Concord effective on or after April 8, 2002 at a bi-weekly salary of \$807.70 with a six month probationary period.

Section 2. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


