ORDINANCE NO. E-6-13-1

ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE HEALTH SAVINGS ACCOUNT CONTRIBUTIONS FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Village Council has established Health Savings Accounts for employees, and;

WHEREAS, Village Council desires to change the village annual contribution to employee Health Savings Accounts, and;


WHEREAS, Village Council deems this ordinance to be necessary to the health, safety, welfare and long term fiscal integrity of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. The village shall contribute \$1,000 to qualified employee's Health Savings Accounts through semi-annual payments of \$500 beginning in July 2013.




