

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

**ORDINANCE NO. E-8-14-2**

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE APPOINTMENT OF AND TO EMPLOY A VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY, BENEFITS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYEMENT FOR A VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest and for the immediate preservation of the safety and welfare of the Village of New Concord that a Village Administrator be hired to fill a vacancy; and

WHEREAS, candidates have been considered and interviewed and Charlotte Colley was selected by the mayor and village council search committee as the best candidate for the job; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the mayor to appoint the Village Administrator with the approval of village council; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have a full time Village Administrator who has the authority to manage the water works, sewer system , streets system as well as other functions of the Village for the health, safety and welfare of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE be it ordained, by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Muskingum County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1. The mayor is hereby authorized to appoint and enter into an employment agreement with Charlotte Colley to be employed as Administrator of the Village of New Concord at an annual salary of \$64,000 effective September 10, 2014 which shall increase according to the employment agreement after successful completion of a six month probationary period to an annual salary of \$66,000 .

Section 2. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force at the earliest point allowed by law.


