

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD

ORDINANCE E-9-96-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE E-3-96-1 AND E-3-96-2 TO GRANT AN INCREASE IN SALARY FOR TWO EMPLOYEES IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR COMPLETION OF A SIX MONTH PROBATION PERIOD AND AS A MERIT AWARD FOR PERFORMANCE AS PART OF THE ONE YEAR EVALUATION PERIOD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Harry Domoracki has successfully completed his six month probationary period,
and

WHEREAS, Daniel P. Corder has been evaluated upon the anniversary date of his hire as established by Village policy, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Domoracki and Mr. Corder have performed their respective duties in an exemplary manner and have received positive evaluations from Chief Stewart, and

WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this ordinance is in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the Village,


NOW, therefore, be it ordained by the council of the Village of New Concord that:

Section 1: The salary for Mr. Domoracki shall be increase \$900 per annum to \$16,900 retroactive to August 13, 1996;

Section 2: The salary for Mr. Corder shall be increased \$500 per annum to \$18,000 retroactive to September 1, 1996;

Section 3: For the reasons stated in the preamble this ordinance shall be declared an emergency and take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
