ORDINANCE NO. E-9-97-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. E-12-96-1,
TO GRANT AN INCREASE IN SALARY FOR OUTSTANDING
PERFORMANCE AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. E-12-96-1 established salaries and wages for 1997, including Martha L. Martin, income tax/police clerk and Clerk of Courts, and;

WHEREAS, Mrs. Martin has been evaluated upon the anniversary date of hire as set forth in Village policy, and;

WHEREAS, Martha L. Martin has performed her duties in an exemplary manner, showing initiative and service over and above that required by her job description, and;


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest and for the immediate preservation of the safety and welfare of the Village that an hourly increase of 32 cents be granted Mrs. Martin.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:


Section 1. The salary for Martha L. Martin be \$7.00 per hour retroactive to August 1, 1997.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble which is hereby made a part hereof, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
