REPORTS

Solicitor: Nothing to report.

Police Chief: Chief Hayes gave the July monthly report.

- 1) Reported 13 offenses in July, with a total of 177 calls for service.
- 2) Chief Hayes reported police department successfully moved to a 4, 10 hour work week for the officers. This schedule will allow for a small overlap of coverage, this is a large step toward maintaining 24/7 coverage.
- 3) Chief Hayes reported locker room in the police department office was completed, allowing a place to store gear and uniforms.

Fire Chief: Chief Gates gave the July monthly report.

- 1) Reported 14 fire runs and 88 EMS runs for July with percentage of run totals staying steady.

Mayor: Mayor Adams announced Celebrate New Concord final performance will be August 18th with Muskingum Jazz Group performing.

Policy: Bronner reported committee met prior to meeting.

- 1) Bronner reported committee discussed working with staff to develop a Welcome Packet for incoming students and residents/businesses new to the Village. Welcome Packet to include Village staff contacts, Council information, Ordinance information and other resources in the Village.

Infrastructure: Dickson reported committee met.

- 1) Dickson reported committee supported Resolution 8-15-1 to advertise for bids for replacement of the Village Hall roof.
- 2) Reported staff waiting on revised Thompson curb prices that include sidewalk quote from Comin Street to top of the hill on Thompson.
- 3) Dickson reported tree removal at 168 Montgomery is in favor with owner, who is willing to plant new tree. Staff working to contact 188 Montgomery.
- 4) Committee would like to revisit the sidewalk assistance program to determine if the assistance amount is in line with current costs to repair/replace sidewalks.
