

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. F-12-11-2

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. F-2-11-1, TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS AND REDUCE CERTAIN FUNDS DURING THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2011 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the certificate of estimated resources has been received from the Muskingum County Budget Commission enabling this council to enact a permanent appropriations ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary that the Fiscal Officer be able to pay current expenses of the Village for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that the following sums are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

Section 1. That there be appropriated funds as follows:


A1	General Fund	\$480,000
A1	General Fund Police Expenses	\$60,000
B4	Recreation Fund Personnel	\$18,000
B4	Recreation Fund	\$20,000
B6	Street Levy Fund	\$130,000
C5	North Friendship Sewer Debt	\$26,000
D2	WWTP Improvement	\$650,000
E1	Water Fund	\$220,000

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble above, which is made a part hereof, this Ordinance is hereby declared to an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from its passage.




