ORDINANCE NO. F-4-12-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. F-2-12-1, TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS DURING THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2012 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the certificate of estimated resources has been received from the Muskingum County Budget Commission enabling this council to amend the permanent appropriations ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary that the Fiscal Officer be able to pay current expenses of the Village for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that the following sums are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

E7 N. Friendship W.L. Const. Fund	-0-	\$75,000	\$75,000




