ORDINANCE NO. F-5-97-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. F-2-97-1,  
TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS, TO  
REAPPROPRIATE VARIOUS SUMS OF MONEY WITHIN  
FUNDS, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. F-2-97-1 established appropriations in various funds for the Village of New Concord, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make additional appropriations and/or transfer appropriations in some funds for the reasons that the funds have insufficient appropriations to continue the operations of the Village, and

WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this Ordinance is necessary for the public health, safety and general welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. F-2-97-1 be amended to include additional appropriations to the following funds:

Program VII 875. C5-7-G-234


Section 2. That Ordinance No. F-2-97-1 be further amended to read as follows:




