

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. F-5-98-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. F-2-98-1, TO REDUCE APPROPRIATIONS IN ONE FUND, TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS, TO REAPPROPRIATE VARIOUS SUMS OF MONEY WITHIN FUNDS, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. F-2-98-1 established appropriations in various funds for the Village of New Concord, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to reduce appropriations in one fund, to make additional appropriations and/or transfer appropriations in various funds for the reasons that the funds have insufficient appropriations to continue the operations of the Village, and

WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this Ordinance is necessary for the public health, safety and general welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. F-2-98-1 be amended to reduce appropriations by \$27,000 in the Main Street Lighting Fund to the following level as listed in the funds below:






