

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. H-11-98-1

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM TOGETHER WITH ALL OF THE NECESSARY APPURTENANCES THERETO THAT BENEFIT UNSEWERED PROPERTIES WITHIN THE VILLAGE ON RIX MILLS ROAD AND RESERVOIR ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of New Concord, County of Muskingum, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The revised assessments for the cost and expense of the design and construction of sanitary sewers pursuant to Resolution 4-98-1 passed on April 13, 1998 serving ten (10) properties on Rix Mills Road and Reservoir Road amounting in aggregate to \$21,000 filed in this office shall hereby be the same are hereby adopted and confirmed and such revised estimates are hereby levied and assessed upon the lands and lots benefiting from such improvements in the respective amounts in the schedule of revised assessments, which assessments are in proportion to the benefits received and are not in excess of any statutory limit.

Section 2. This Council hereby finds and determines that the revised assessments as now on file in the office of the Clerk/Treasurer of this Village are in the same proportion to the estimated assessments as originally filed as the actual cost of the above described improvement is to the estimated cost of the improvement as originally levied.

Section 3. The assessments against each parcel or lot at the option of the property owner is payable in cash in ten (10) annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the loan issued by the Ohio Water Development Authority for the design and construction of said sanitary sewer project. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid shall be certified by the Clerk/Treasurer to the County Auditor as provided by law to be placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 4. The Clerk/Treasurer shall cause a notice of the passage of this Ordinance to be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in this Village and to continue on file in his office said revised assessments.

Section 5. The Clerk/Treasurer of this Village is hereby directed to deliver a certified copy of this Ordinance to the County Auditor within twenty (20) days after its passage.

Section 6. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.


