ORDINANCE NO. I-1-14-1

ORDINANCE NO. I-1-14-1, AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE I-2-02-1 TO INCREASE THE VILLAGE MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX RATES TO ONE AND ONE HALF PERCENT UPON APPROVED BY A MAJORITY OF THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD TO FUND THE OPERATION OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD SAFETY SERVICES, FIRST READING.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Concord by Resolution 12-13-5 has determined that it is necessary to submit to the electors of the Village of New Concord, Muskingum County, Ohio, the question of increasing the municipal income tax rate from one percent (1%) to one and one half of one percent (1.5%) in order to fund the operation of the Village of New Concord Safety Services; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Council of the Village of New Concord to amend Ordinance I-2-02-1 to increase the municipal income tax rate from one percent (1%) to one and one half of one percent (1.5%) upon approval of a majority of the electors of the Village of New Concord, and

WHEREAS, approval of this ordinance is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Muskingum County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. Upon approval by a majority of the electors of the Village of New Concord, Section 3. of Ordinance I-2-02-1 shall be replaced and amended to read and be in effect as follows:

IMPOSITION OF INCOME TAX "Subject to the provisions of Section 17 of this ordinance, an annual income tax for the purposes specified in Section 1. is hereby imposed at the rate of one and one half of one percent (1.5%) per year effective January 1, 2015 upon the following:"

Section 2. All other provisions of I-2-02-1 shall remain in effect.




