

IN THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. I-11-00-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RULES AND REGULATIONS UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF SECTION 9, VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD INCOME TAX ORDINANCE NO. I-12-82-1, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Concord has passed and the Mayor of the Village of New Concord has Ordinance No. I-12-82-1; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to adopt certain rules and regulations relating to the administration of provisions of Ordinance No. I-12-82-1; and

WHEREAS, Village Council desires to amend said Income Tax Ordinance to permit funds to be deposited directly into the "General Fund" and eliminate duplicative transferring of funds; and

WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this ordinance is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:


Section 1. Ordinance I-12-82-1 Section 9 "Allocation of Funds" shall be amended to read:

"Funds collected under the provisions of this ordinance shall be deposited in the Income Tax Fund or the General Fund and said funds shall be disbursed in the following order, to-wit;

1. Such part thereof as shall be necessary to defray all costs of collecting the taxes and the cost of administering and enforcing the provisions thereof.
2. The net available income tax receipts received annually may be used for any purpose permitted by law and may, from time to time, be transferred to other funds and appropriated for such purposes.


Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
