**ORDINANCE NO. K-8-99-2**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES K-3-97-2, K-3-96-1 AND K-5-94-1 FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE ZONING CODE LANGUAGE.

WHEREAS, it is periodically necessary to amend the zoning code to reflect the character of the Village; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to control the number, size and location of temporary signs to compatible with the character of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has recommended the adoption of this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord that:

Section 701.7 shall be amended as follows:

*Delete* "1. Temporary Signs"


Section 707 shall be amended as follows:

*Add* "707.8 - Temporary Signs and Banners - no temporary signs shall be permitted on any premises unless specifically permitted herein."


Section 709.3 shall be amended as follows:


*Replace current language with* "Window Signs - temporary window signs may be used for special events, but shall not be used for more than 30 consecutive days, shall only be permitted on the interior of buildings, shall be subject to the requirements of Section 410, and may not exceed 50% of any window area"
