**RESOLUTION NO. 1-03-1**

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR DEMOLITION OF VILLAGE OWNED BUILDINGS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village no longer has a useful purpose for structures it owns at 76 W. Maple Avenue, and

WHEREAS, it is proper to advertise for and receive bids for said work, and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village to advertise for bids for construction as soon as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and instructed to advertise for not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation for bids for demolition of two structures.




