RESOLUTION NO. 1-11-1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR PUMP SYSTEM AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT PHASE II PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Concord has determined that is necessary for the health and safety of the village residents to purchase a pump system and construct improvements at the wastewater treatment plant.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that;

Section 1. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and instructed to advertise for not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation for bids for the purchase of a pump system.

Section 2. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and instructed to advertise for not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation for construct improvements at the wastewater treatment plant.

Section 3. That this measure constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


