

RESOLUTION NO. 1-12-1

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE NEW CONCORD PLANNING COMMISSION TO CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER RECOMMENDATIONS FOR AMENDMENTS TO VILLAGE ZONING ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Concord has determined that periodic updates to the Zoning Ordinances are legal and necessary; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Planning Commission to hold a public hearing and make recommendations regarding zoning amendments; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the village that zoning amendments be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that;

Section 1. Village Council request that the Village Planning commission make recommendations to Village Council for zoning amendments regarding the following:


- Solar Panels
- Wind Turbines
- Oil and Gas Drilling and Wells
- Oil and Gas Transport Services
- Energy Production Facilities
- Condominiums and Clustered Housing
- Site Plan Requirements
- Multi Family Zoning

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is made a part hereof, the Resolution is hereby declared to be in full force after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

Section 3. That this measure constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
