RESOLUTION NO. 10-01-4

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY IN THE OPERATION OF THE NEW CONCORD SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT AND PROVIDING FOR THE IMMEDIATE PURCHASE OF SLUDGE PROCESSING EQUIPMENT WITHOUT FORMAL BIDDING AND ADVERTISING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the New Concord Sewage Treatment Plant cannot adequately process sludge and comply with Ohio EPA regulations, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to order said equipment in advance of construction, and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 735.05.1 provides for emergency purchases without formal bidding and advertising, and

WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of the resolution is necessary to the health, safety and welfare of the Village.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. It is hereby determined that a real and present emergency exists and that the immediate purchase of sludge processing equipment is necessary for the environment of the area.

Section 2. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a contract and proceed with said purchase.

Section 3. That for the reasons stated in the preamble, this resolution shall be declared an emergency and shall take effect and be in full force immediately after it's passage and approval by the Mayor.




