**RESOLUTION NO. 12-10-7**

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE FIRE CHIEF TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH CENTURY NATIONAL BANK FOR THE LEASE/PURCHASE OF AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SQUAD VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the lease-purchase of equipment may be done without competitive bidding;  
and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Village to enter into agreements immediately to provide services necessary to the health, safety and welfare of the Village residents, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The Fire Chief be authorized to enter into finance agreements through Century National Bank, not to exceed \$236,000 for a 7 year term at 4.00%.

Section 2. As stated in the preamble hereto, this resolution shall be an emergency measure and take effect immediately as permitted by law.



**RESOLUTION NO. 12-10-6**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FIRE CHIEF TO PURCHASE A FULLY EQUIPPED EMERGENCY MEDICAL SQUAD VEHICLE AND TWO ADDITIONAL HEART MONITORS EXCEEDING \$25,000 WITHOUT BIDS AT THE STATE PURCHASING PROGRAM PRICE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the law certain purchases may be made without competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Fire Department to make certain purchases;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The Fire Chief be authorized to purchase an emergency medical squad vehicle without bids at the State Purchasing Program price, Penn Care Public Safety Technology, not to exceed \$180,000.

Section 2. The Fire Chief be authorized to purchase two additional heart monitors without bids at the State Purchasing Program from Physio-Control Inc. for a total price not to exceed \$56,000.

Section 3. As stated in the preamble hereto, this resolution shall be an emergency measure and take effect immediately as permitted by law.


