RESOLUTION NO. 12-14-1

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE OHIO PATHWAY THROUGH SPACE NATIONAL HERITAGE AREA IN THE STATE OF OHIO, SECOND READING.

WHEREAS the state of Ohio has made a significant contribution to space exploration and to America's space program as Ohio astronauts have made a total of seventy-eight space flights, three trips to the moon, and have logged over twenty-two thousand hours in space, and

WHEREAS Ohio's twenty-five astronauts include, Neil A. Armstrong, Charles A. Basset II, Kenneth D. Cameron, Nancy J. Currie, Donn F. Eisele, Michael J. Foreman, Michael L. Gernhardt, John H. Glenn Jr., Michael T. Good, Gregory J. Harbaugh, Karl G. Heinze, Thomas J. Hennen, Terence T. Henricks, Gregory H. Jonson, James A. Lovell, G. David Low, Robert F. Overmyer, Ronald A. Parise, Judith A. Resnik, Ronald M. Sega, Robert C. Springer, Donald A. Thomas, Carl E. Walz, Mary Ellen Weber, and Sunita L. Williams, and

WHEREAS John H. Glenn Jr. became the first American to orbit the Earth on February 20, 1962, and returned to space on October 29, 1998, as the oldest person to date at the age of seventy-seven, and

WHEREAS the Village of New Concord is the hometown of astronaut John Glenn, and

WHEREAS the state of Ohio is home to the Armstrong Air and Space Museum, the University of Cincinnati Commemorative Archives Collection, the John Glenn School of Public Affairs at the Ohio State University, the John & Annie Glenn Historic Site, the International Women's Air and Space Museum, the Center of Science and Industry, the NASA Glenn Center, the National Museum of the United States Air Force, the First Flight Lunar Module Memorial, the Great Lakes Science Center, and the Museum of Natural History and Science, and

WHEREAS there is considerable popular support for the establishment of a National Heritage Area in the state of Ohio to commemorate Ohio's important contribution to space exploration and to America's space program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of New Concord,
Ohio that:

Section 1. The New Concord Village Council urges the United States Congress to pass, and the President to sign, a bill establishing the Ohio Pathway Through Space National Heritage Area.


Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.


