RESOLUTION NO. 2-02-1

A RESOLUTION DETERMING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT CLARIFIERS AND IMPROVEMENTS FROM DOWNING CONSTRUCTION COMPANY OF BALTIMORE, OHIO AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER VILLAGE OFFICIALS TO ENTER INTO THE NECESSARY CONTRACTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a notice to bidders was published in accordance with the law; and

WHEREAS, the immediate purchase of labor, equipment and materials for the project is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:


Section 1. It is hereby determined that the bid from Downing Construction Company for \$465,000 is the lowest responsive and responsible bid and that the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for such purchase in accordance with the bid.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble this resolution shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.


