RESOLUTION NO. 2-03-1

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE STREET ASSESSMENT FUND TO THE STREET SWEEPER DEBT FUND, FROM THE FIRE/EMS FUND TO THE FEMA FIRE EQUIPMENT PURCHASE FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, monies from the various funds of the Village of New Concord may be transferred to various other funds according to law, and

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary that the Clerk/Treasurer be able to pay operating expenses and other expenses of the Village for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the Village of New Concord.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. Monies be transferred during the year as required by the Clerk/Treasurer, between Village funds as follows:

From the Street Assessment Fund (B6) to the Street Sweeper Debt Fund (C16) \$19,657.30
From the Fire/EMS Fund (B8) to the FEMA Fire Equipment Purchase Fund (D9) \$9,000

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


