RESOLUTION NO. 2-03-2

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR MATERIALS AND LABOR FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A MAINTENANCE BUILDING WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the New Concord Water, Sewer and Street Departments need additional space and the existing building is in disrepair and inadequate; and

WHEREAS, it is proper to advertise for and receive bids for said building; and


WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village to advertise for bids for construction as soon as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and instructed to advertise for not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation for bids for construction of a new maintenance building.






