A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN INSURANCE SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR PROPERTY, LIABILITY, FLEET, INLAND MARINE AND UMBRELLA INSURANCE FOR THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village through its council has previously declared the necessity of obtaining insurance coverage for buildings and contents, inland marine, boiler and machinery, auto physical damage, comprehensive auto liability and comprehensive general liability, and;

WHEREAS, the Village has requested proposals for the same and;

WHEREAS, the proposal from Wichert Insurance Services Inc., representing Selective Insurance Company has been determined to be the best of five proposals received by the Village, and;


WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this resolution is necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the Village, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:



Section 2. That the Resolution be declared an emergency and shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.




