RESOLUTION NO. 3-11-3

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF UNNECESSARY VILLAGE EQUIPMENT TO THE HIGHEST BIDDERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, bids were received to sell unneeded equipment; and

WHEREAS, the immediate sale of said Village equipment is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to sell to the highest bidder unnecessary items and equipment owned by the village including a semi trailer, 2001 police cruiser, and a 1995 Ford Dump Truck.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.




