RESOLUTION NO. 3-11-5

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF TO PURCHASE A FOUR WHEEL DRIVE POLICE VEHICLE WITHOUT BIDS AT THE STATE PURCHASING PROGRAM PRICE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the law certain purchases may be made without competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Police Department to make certain purchases;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The Police Chief be authorized to purchase a four wheel drive police vehicle without bids at the State Purchasing Program price, Penn Care Public Safety Technology, not to exceed \$26,000.

Section 2. As stated in the preamble hereto, this resolution shall be an emergency measure and take effect immediately as permitted by law.


