RESOLUTION NO. 3-11-6

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH HUNTINGTON NATIONAL BANK FOR THE LEASE/PURCHASE OF A POLICE VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the lease-purchase of equipment may be done without competitive bidding;
and


WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Village to enter into agreements immediately to provide services necessary to the health, safety and welfare of the Village residents, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio that:


Section 1. The Village Administrator be authorized to enter into finance agreements through Huntington National Bank, not to exceed \$24,800 for a 5 year term at 3.79%.


Section 2. As stated in the preamble hereto, this resolution shall be an emergency measure and take effect immediately as permitted by law.


