

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

RESOLUTION NO. 4-00-3

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUSKINGUM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO DISTRIBUTE FUNDS, RECEIVED IN LIEU OF ABATED PROPERTY TAXES FROM GENERAL WAREHOUSE REPLACING ROAD AND BRIDGE TAXES, TO UNION TOWNSHIP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the State Urban Jobs and Enterprise Zone Program, and to Resolutions of the Village of New Concord and Muskingum County adopted in accordance therewith, a rural enterprise zone has been designated in a geographic area described in the Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Muskingum County adopted November 18, 1996.

WHEREAS, pursuant to its Ordinance adopted February 9, 1993, and said County Resolution adopted November 18, 1996, a proposed Enterprise Zone Agreement affecting the Village of New Concord is to be submitted to the Village Council for its consent and approval; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its Ordinance adopted October 13, 1997, the Village of New Concord entered into pre-annexation agreement with Union Township, providing for the sharing of real property and personal property taxes for projects locating in the annexed territory; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Muskingum County have received a Proposal for a Project at 35 Rix Mills Road, New Concord, Ohio, pursuant to the State Urban Jobs and Enterprise Zone Program from New Concord, Ohio, Inc., General Warehouse & Transportation Co. and Colgate-Palmolive Co. (the Companies), and the County proposes to enter into an Enterprise Zone Agreement providing for a Project and real property and personal property tax exemptions therefore with the Companies, and such Proposal and the proposed form of the Enterprise Zone Agreement have been made available to the Village Council of New Concord for its consent and approval; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the pre-annexation agreement approved by the Village of New Concord and Union Township, the Board of Trustees of Union Township must endorse any Enterprise Zone Agreement proposed to the Village of New Concord that lies within the annexation territory and the endorsement must be prior to the Village of New Concord proceeding to grant said Agreement; and


WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this resolution is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the Council of the Village of New Concord hereby endorses the specific rates and language of the Companies' Proposal and the Enterprise Zone Agreement proposed to be entered into between the Companies and the County for a project located at 35 Rix Mills Road, and authorizes the Muskingum County Commissioners to disperse any payment in lieu from the company as the funds normally would be divided for real and personal property tax in the Village of New Concord, except that the revenue that would

normally be paid for the road and bridge tax may be paid directly to Union Township. The effect being that the payment to the township would be the same as required by the annexation agreement between the Village of New Concord and Union Township.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.


