RESOLUTION NO. 4-00-4

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS AND PROCEEDINGS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A UTILITY TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the appropriate committees of Village Council have approved the purchase of a utility truck; and


WHEREAS, the advertisement for bids and purchase of a utility truck is necessary to the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, that:

Section 1. The Clerk is hereby authorized and instructed to advertise for not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the county for bids to purchase a utility truck and to open and publicly read the bids at the time, date and place listed in the advertisement.


Section 2. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, this resolution is hereby declared an emergency and shall take effect after it's passage and approval by the Mayor.


