

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

RESOLUTION NO. 4-11-1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PROPER VILLAGE OFFICIALS TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND MOST RESPONSIBLE BID FOR THE SPECIFIED EQUIPMENT, ELECTRICAL WORK, AND THE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION OF THE WWTP PHASE II IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Concord has determined that the purchase of the specified equipment, electrical work and the general construction of the WWTP Phase II Improvements Project is necessary for the health and safety of the village residents, and;

WHEREAS, advertisements for bids have been published in accordance with the law, and;

WHEREAS, competitive sealed bids were received and opened in accordance with the law, and;


WHEREAS, the bids have been reviewed by a licensed professional engineer for compliance with the approved specifications and a written recommendation for the lowest and best bid has been submitted to village officials.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that;

Section 1. The Mayor, Village Administrator, Solicitor and the Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into contracts for the purchase of the specified pumps and controls and the general construction and electrical work from the lowest and most responsive bidder, Zemba Brothers, Inc. for the bid price - \$549,780.86.


Section 2. That this measure constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


