RESOLUTION NO. 4-12-1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PROPER VILLAGE OFFICIALS TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID AND PROCEED WITH A CONTRACT FOR THE NORTH FRIENDSHIP WATER LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a notice to bidders was published in accordance with the law, and;


WHEREAS, the immediate purchase of labor, equipment and materials for the project is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that;

Section 1. It is hereby determined that the bid from Zemba Bros., Inc. for \$59,814.27 is the lowest responsive and responsible bid and that the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for such purchase in accordance with the bid.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.




