**RESOLUTION NO. 6-00-1**

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A PORTION OF NEW CONCORD AS A REDEVELOPMENT DISTRICT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord desires to improve the area around Muskingum College at the north edge of the Village by investing in public infrastructure and encouraging private investment; and

WHEREAS, the Village must meet a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Housing and Urban Development (HUD) national objective to qualify for federal funding for these improvements; and

WHEREAS, the immediate adoption of this resolution is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Muskingum County, State of Ohio that:


Section 1. The proposed east Muskingum Walking Trail from Stormont School to John Glenn High School be designated as a Redevelopment District to meet HUD Slum and Blight National Objective qualifications. The District is shown on the attached Map A.

Section 2. Based on a survey of the Redevelopment District, 60% of the public improvements are substandard. These include walkways and lighting.


Section 3. The Village Administrator is authorized to prepare and submit to the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) all required documents and information to have the Redevelopment District Approved.

Section 4. For the reasons stated in the preamble, this resolution shall take effect at the earliest point allowed by law.
