RESOLUTION NO. 6-02-2

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR MATERIALS AND LABOR FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE STATE ROUTE 83/U.S. ROUTE 40 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in order to improve the safety of the above intersection it is necessary to construct improvements; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village to advertise for bids for construction as soon as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Clerk of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and instructed to advertise for not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation for bids for the construction of the State Route 83/U.S. Route 40 Improvements.




