RESOLUTION NO. 7-04-2

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PROPER VILLAGE OFFICIALS TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH VERIZON WIRELESS IN ORDER TO LEASE SPACE FOR AN ANTENNA ON VILLAGE PROPERTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village desires to lease space on the water storage tank to be used by Verizon Wireless for a cellular phone antenna.

WHEREAS, an agreement is required prior to leasing property; and

WHEREAS, the Village is permitted by law to lease property for said purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Mayor and Village Administrator are authorized to enter into lease agreement as necessary and are hereby authorized to lease property owned by the Village of New Concord known as the elevated storage tank to Verizon Wireless Inc.

Section 2. That this measure constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
